Cocoa Test

ICE Futures U.S., Inc. will be administering the Cocoa graders test in October 2020. The test will be conducted at our grading facility located at 55 East 52nd Street, New York, NY.

In accordance with Exchange rules, an applicant for a license as a Cocoa grader must have a minimum of three (3) years of experience in the cocoa industry. Any Independent licensed sampler or warehouse personnel shall be eligible as a licensed cocoa grader.

Qualified candidates interested in receiving an application package for the Cocoa test should submit a request before September 1, 2020 to commoditiesoperations@theice.com.

All applicants are advised that, pursuant to Exchange rules, successful candidates will be required to grade on the Exchange a minimum of 2 times every year in order to maintain an ICE U.S. license as a grader.
